*Last year we had a tremendous year, serving nearly 3200 meals, and are on pace this year to exceed that number. We recently started allowing guests back inside our hall to get their meal and take advantage of our wonderful give-away table. Guests also have the option of receiving their meal through the drive-up option.*

*This year's Great Give yielded our best outcome to date, at over \$3300 from 31 individual donors. That's \$800 more than last year! Thank you for your support.*

*We were also able to provide 4 \$500 scholarships to seniors from Emmett O'Brian Technical High School, who were the recipients of the 2022 Patrick McCabe Memorial Scholarship.*

*We also would like to welcome to new members of our Board of Directors, Lisa Hurlbert and Arlene Greco. Both bring a lot of experience and positive energy. Welcome to the team!!!*
